#### **Qualifications:**

Head coach must demonstrate knowledge of sport, skills and strategies to principal or designate.

All coaches must be familiar with and implement, where applicable, the criteria outlined in <u>Coaches Expectations</u>.

At least one wrestling coach must possess one of the following coaching qualifications:

- NCCP Competition Coach Competition-Introduction Part 1 Course
- NCCP Competition Coach Competition-Introduction Part 2 Course
- Accreditation as a NCCP Wrestling Learning Facilitator
- Completion of wrestling NCCP level 1 and/or level 2 certification in the past
- Attendance at a clinic or workshop within the last three years provided by an instructor who is knowledgeable of the activity (e.g., appropriate skills and progressions), and where safety is addressed as outlined in the Ontario Physical Activity Safety Standards in Education.
- Past experience within the last 3 years as a coach in wrestling, having knowledge of the activity (e.g., appropriate skills and progressions) and current safety practices as outlined in the Ontario Physical Activity Safety Standards in Education.
